### Pathways Tip of the Month

#### Pathways Small Bites: Break it into smaller pieces.

Have you started level 1? The flow of level 1 is a bit different than projects from the traditional program. Are you confident about what you need to do? If you're feeling a little lost. Try this.

After you activate your project, use the navigation bar at the bottom of the screen to navigate to the "Your Evaluation" section. Select the option "Print Your Project". This prints your project in the order that you should complete the activities.

Included in the printout are the resource documents. There are three projects in Level 1 - print each, This will help you organize and keep track of your activities.
